## Limitations:

2. Funds are not awarded for general operating expenses, salaries, tuition, travel, or tournament entry fees.
3. Funds are not awarded to for-profit businesses.
4. In general, the maximum amount awarded per grant is \$1,000.

## To apply:

1. Determine that your request meets the above guidelines and restrictions.

3. Applications must be received by the **third Friday of the month** in order to be considered at the following week's board meeting.
4. Be present at the board meeting to make a five-minute presentation in order for the request to be considered. Board meetings are held the 1<sup>st</sup> Tuesday of each month at 5:30pm in the Truckee DonnerPUD boardroom.

## Funding Requirements

1. You will be notified on whether or not you receive funding within one week after you present at a Rotary board meeting.
2. If you receive funding, you will be expected to:
